A family-focused residential substance use treatment program for mothers and their children.

The Program

The Fresh Start Recovery Center focuses on helping mothers recover from opioid and other drug addictions and have healthy children. Fresh Start Recovery Center serves pregnant women and mothers struggling with substance use disorders.

This program uniquely allows mothers and children to remain together during treatment. We are located in Indianapolis, Winchester and Evansville and accept referrals from anywhere in Indiana.

Our residential treatment provides 24/7 support to clients. During their stay, clients receive services tailored to their goals.

This program meets the American Society of Addiction Medicine level 3.5 criteria and is accredited by Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities.
